BENEFITS PROGRAM SERVICES

The IndependenceFirst Benefits Program assists individuals who receive disability benefits in understanding how working will affect their benefits. A Benefits Specialist can provide a thorough breakdown of the benefits and services a person with a disability receives and the effect that income from employment will have on continued eligibility and benefit amounts.

Benefits Services Include:

-  Face-to-face meeting with a certified Benefits Specialist
-  Discussion of individual's situation and work goals
-  Explanation of current benefits and services including Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI), Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Medicaid, Medicare, FoodShare, and housing assistance
-  Identification of additional benefits and services
-  Explanation of the Social Security work incentives and employment supports
-  Additional health insurance options
-  Written report that summarizes all information, which is individualized, comprehensive, and confidential
